## GIS IN CENTRAL ASIA CONFERENCE – GISCA 2019

The annual 'GIS in Central Asia' - GISCA 2019 is currently accepting registrations for this conference scheduled for May 30-June 1 in Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan. The main objectives of this English language conference are to bring together GIS academics, researchers and practitioners from Central Asian and other countries and to encourage international cooperation and knowledge exchange in GIS education.

In 2019, GISCA is focused on the theme "*From Spatial Data to Spatial Intelligence*". Geographic Information Science as a conceptual foundation, Geoinformatics as the methodology and GIS as software technologies are powerful instruments for linking information across different sources by location. This is exactly what is needed to successfully manage our environments and natural resources, our economies and ultimately our societies.

The GISCA conference series and its publications are managed by the Austria-Central Asia Centre for GIScience - ACA\*GIScience supported by Eurasia-Pacific Uninet, Austrian Academy of Sciences' Commission for GIScience and the Research Center for Ecology and Environment of Central Asia (RCEECA CAS). The conference looks forward to additional sponsorship from the Geoinformatics industry.

The conference committee accepts scientific papers on the stated conference themes with a focus on the Central Asian Region. Active participation in the conference is invited via presentation of a paper or poster, or through workshop attendance. Accepted papers in English will be reviewed and published in the periodical scientific journal "Bulletin of KSUCTA". Selected papers will be recommended for publication in the International Journal of Geoinformatics (http://e-geoinfo.net).
